Emissions reduction targets


This is the organisation's first carbon footprint and emissions reduction commitment.

In order to achieve Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next 10 years to 108.3 tCO₂e by 2032.

This is a reduction of 65%.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2022 baseline. The measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

Carbon reduction projects have included:

- ISO 14001 re-certification
- Virtual meetings using video conferencing, reducing in-work travel
- Reducing the number of printers and using online signing services
- Print edition of our publication reduced from 4 to 2 issues per annum

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Improve data and reporting accuracy.
- Installation of LED lighting.
- Manage and optimize the power consumption of assets through software solutions and purchasing.
- Work in partnership with the landlord to improve business management systems to reduce energy use.
- Engage with supply chain and request they produce their own carbon footprint data and commit to net zero.
